

Action taken report on Feedback (Academic Year: 2023-24)

Our college is highly regarded in the Banaskantha district. The objective is to deliver high quality education to the residents of Banaskantha District. Therefore the college is prioritising all the necessary components needed to provide high quality education. Consequently our college is receiving a very high assessment from the stakeholders so far.


- (1) 93% of students have expressed satisfaction regarding the curriculum. It carries skill-based concepts, provides scientific knowledge and is designed to cater to employability. Around 8% of the students were called face-to-face regarding the above aspects of the curriculum which made them understand the value of the existing course.
- (2) 87% of the students remarked 'Very Good' and 'Excellent' regarding the applicability of the syllabus to real life situations. In addition to core and minor courses, students are offered to opt for soft skill courses including NSS, NCC and Personality Development which teach them how to lead their lives in times of crisis.
- (3) According to the feedback received about the teachers, 82% of the students have expressed their satisfaction. Accordingly, the teachers are giving life-oriented, value-oriented education to their students in addition to the curriculum, as well as providing advice and proper guidance about getting employment in the future.
- (4) Feedback on the overall rating also indicates a satisfactory outcome. Respective departments organize seminars, expert lectures and workshops. Students are satisfied with the physical facilities, library, sports, gymnasium, etc. In this regard, efforts were made to provide these benefits to more and more students.
- (5) Appointments are made on an ad-hoc basis by the governing body in view of shortage of non-teaching staff.

The faculty vice workload is fixed in the college, where the number of students in the faculty or division is high. The governing body tries to promote qualitative teaching and appointing qualified and experienced teachers by advertising in the newspapers.

Various activities are carried out by each department during the year and by this department photographs and reports of various activities are prepared and press notes are given in the newspapers. Press notes, photographs and reports are preserved in each department. Important activities are uploaded to the college website.

- (6) The BKDKM has appointed non-academic staff on a contractual basis to ensure that the office runs well throughout the academic year 2023-24.
- (7) The BKDKM has established contractual appointments for academic staff, to guarantee that academic activities continue to run smoothly.




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
