Introduction

The purpose of this feedback report is to evaluate and summarize the perceptions of college students regarding various aspects of their academic and campus experience. By collecting student feedback, the college aims to identify strengths and areas for improvement, ensuring a higher quality of education and overall student satisfaction.

Purpose of the Feedback:

- To assess students' experiences across various dimensions such as teaching quality, infrastructure, learning resources, extracurricular activities, and support services.
- To highlight areas where the college excels and pinpoint areas that may require enhancement.
- To provide actionable insights for improving the overall student experience, including academic and non-academic aspects.

(1) Process of Collecting Feedback:

- Feedback are collected from all students of Commerce and Science streams from July 2023 to April 2024.
- A structured feedback form was provided through online platform and included both quantitative and qualitative questions. Students were asked to rate different aspects of their experience and provide comments or suggestions.
- A total number of 360 responses ware received, with a balanced representation from all courses and streams.
- The feedback focuses on the following key areas:
 - Teaching quality
 - Availability and effectiveness of learning resources
 - o College infrastructure
 - Student support services
 - Extracurricular activities

This feedback serves as a crucial tool for continuous improvement, fostering an environment of collaboration between students and the college administration.

(2) Purposes:

- To gather student insights regarding the quality of teaching, learning resources, infrastructure, and overall college experience.
- To identify areas of improvement and strengths in the curriculum and student services.

(3) Methodology:

- Feedbacks are collected using online from students in Commerce and Science
